The dust has now settled on your successful Bronze Expedition and it is time to continue to fulfil all of the other parts of the DofE Bronze award.

Mrs Poulter has kindly agreed to us using some time during CREATE on Monday p6 to do your presentations. By now you should have started your other sections (Skills, Physical and Volunteering) one for 6 months and the other two for 3 months.

The arrangements are as follows:

Monday 30 October

Period 6: Presentations by **Pink Momentum, West Side and Luke, Marley and Me, Mischief and EA7.**

Monday 6 November

Period 6: Presentations by **Big Lez, Gadonkadonk, Toby and the Small people, Magnificent 7 and 3 B's**

To completely pass the expedition, DofE states that 'All participants must deliver a presentation, related to the expeditions aim in order to complete the section; it is entirely up to the team how their presentation is delivered – it could be in any format.' The presentation should also include an account of the journey and a reflection of their experiences.

Presentation ideas:

- Written document/booklet or formal report.
- Images Portfolio or scrapbook of photos, sketches, maps etc.
- Oral presentation Power point, speech or poetry
- A mixture of some of the above

Students should meet in their groups during the **CREATE session p6 on Monday 16 October** and prepare their presentation ready for the allocated time slot. All members of the group need to be part of the presentation. You need to include: The aim of your project and why you chose it, what you found/collected along your walk, how you recorded it and what conclusions have you come to about your project.
